PROJECT HISTORY AND BACKGROUND

- Interchange was studied in 2013-2015 but did not progress
- Midtown Congestion Relief Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) Study concluded in 2020 and recommended five projects
- 36th Avenue Interchange is the first project moving forward






PEL RECOMMENDED PROJECTS

- Project B: Seward Highway / 36th Avenue Intersection Improvements
- **Project C:** Seward Highway / Benson Boulevard, Northern Lights Boulevard and Fireweed
- **Project E:** Seward Highway / Benson Boulevard to 20th Avenue Access Improvements




Median U-turn This option was found to have operational flaws







SEWARD HIGHWAY PROPOSED CROSS SECTION







Seward Highway Northbound Paved Lane Ditch Lane Shoulder




36TH AVENUE LOOKING EAST TOWARDS NORTHBOUND FRONTAGE ROAD INTERSECTION




36TH AVENUE LOOKING WEST TOWARDS OLD SEWARD HIGHWAY INTERSECTION






SEWARD HIGHWAY PROPOSED CROSS SECTION








